Notification to all III Semester Undergraduate students to select multidisciplinary elective - reg.

All III Semester students (except B. Voe. students) have to complete a two-credit elective course during the odd semester of 2025-26. This is a course completion requirement. Students should opt for any **ONE** of the courses listed within their respective schools.

The option to select the multidisciplinary electives (MOE) will be available on the student (Linways) **portal**, as per the following schedule

• Ill semester students can opt for multidisciplinary elective from June 28, 2025, 6:35 pm onwards and the portal will be kept open till June 29, 2025, 11am.

Please note that there will be a cap on the number of students opting for a particular course. The seats will be available on a first-come first serve basis. Students are advised to prioritize their top three multidisciplinary elective options and keep them handy before applying. The syllabi of all the multidisciplinary electives are available on the webpages of the respective schools.

The National Entrepreneurship Network (NEN) syllabus is available under School of IT.

Please note that BSc EMS students will select one of the MDE from the School of Physical Sciences.
