Qualifying Degree

- Masters or equivalent degree in Chemistry/Botany (M.Sc., M.Tech., M.Res.) as applicable.

Requirement (Marks / CGPA / CPI)

- Candidates belonging to the General Merit category should have a **Minimum of 55%** or equivalent grade in the Master's degree
- Candidates belonging to the SC / ST / OBC (only Non-Creamy Layer) / Differently Abled categories to have a **Minimum of 50%** or equivalent grade in the Master's degree

Entrance Test and Interview

- The Entrance Exam will be held on Sunday, 1st December, 2024 from 1pm to 3pm in the SJU Campus
- There will be an entrance test of two-hour duration, carrying 70 marks, based on which a shortlist of candidates will be prepared, followed by an interview for the shortlisted candidates (30 marks). The details of the entrance test, such as the topics/areas that would be tested and the question paper pattern, are available online (website-link).
- Candidates who have qualified NET (JRF/LS), GATE, and KSET (Karnataka) are exempted from the entrance test. They will directly attend the interview (100 marks).
- The selection will be based on the combined score obtained by the candidate in the entrance test and the interview.
