

AICTE SWANATH SCHOLARSHIP BBA & BCA STUDENTS

The AICTE Swanath Scholarship is a financial assistance scheme for students in India pursuing technical education who have faced significant personal loss, such as the death of parents or being wards of martyrs. Below are the key highlights for 2025:

Key Features

- 2,000 Scholarships awarded annually: 1,000 for technical degree students and 1,000 for diploma students.
- Scholarship amount: ₹50,000 per annum for each year of study, paid via Direct Bank Transfer (DBT).
- Tenure: Up to 3 years for diploma students and up to 4 years for degree students.
- Application: Online, through the National Scholarship Portal (scholarships.gov.in).
- **Last date to apply: October 31, 2025.**

Eligibility Criteria

- Open to orphans, students who lost parent(s) to COVID-19, or wards of Armed Forces/Central Paramilitary Forces personnel martyred in action.
- Must be enrolled in a technical course (degree/diploma) at an AICTE-approved institution.
- Family income should not exceed ₹8 lakh per annum from all sources.
- Applicants must not be receiving any other central, state, or AICTE-sponsored scholarship.
- Aadhaar card and bank account in the student's name are mandatory.
- **Students belonging to BBA and BCA**

Selection and Disbursement

- Degree students are selected based on 10+2 marks; diploma students based on 10th marks.
- In case of a tie, preference is given to higher marks in previous class, older age, or lower family income.
- Reservation applies as per Government of India norms.
- Amount is disbursed directly to the student's Aadhaar-seeded bank account via DBT.
