BEMBALA OFFICE OF THE UNIVERSITY DRIVING COMMUNITY OUTREACH

Bembala, meaning "to reach out" in Kannada, is an outreach initiative that aligns with the university's vision of character formation. This program aims to empower marginalized communities through education, awareness, and skill development while fostering a learning environment for students and faculty. It is a mandatory requirement for all undergraduate (UG) and postgraduate (PG) students, with UG students required to complete **60 hours** and PG students **40 hours** of outreach activities. The university's Outreach Center organizes these activities and maintains records of student participation. By the end of the final semester, the Outreach Department submits the list of successful candidates to the Controller of Examinations (COE). Through Bembala, students not only contribute to social development but also acquire essential life skills, values, and attitudes that shape their character and future.

TRAFFIC SAFETY AND AWARENESS INITIATIVE:

To promote a disciplined society, our university students conducted a traffic awareness campaign at Richmond Circle, Nanjappa Circle, and Double Road. Armed with placards and slogans, they emphasized the importance of wearing helmets and seatbelts, highlighting the crucial role of traffic safety and awareness in creating a safer road environment for all users.





PAPER BAG MAKING AND DISTRIBUTION:

As part of an eco-friendly initiative, our students created and distributed paper bags to local shop vendors, promoting a switch from plastic to paper bags. This effort aimed to protect the environment and encourage sustainable practices.



CLEANLINESS DRIVE: PROMOTING ENVIRONMENTAL CONSCIOUSNESS

St. Joseph's Outreach, in collaboration with ITC Green Campus initiative, launched a "Wellbeing out of Waste" project, fostering environmental awareness and sustainable behaviors. The cleanliness drive aimed to educate students and the community about waste segregation and its benefits. Students created posters, conducted sessions on civic sense at a local government school, and engaged children in games and activities to promote environmental consciousness.





SAVE WATER AWARENESS CAMPAIGN

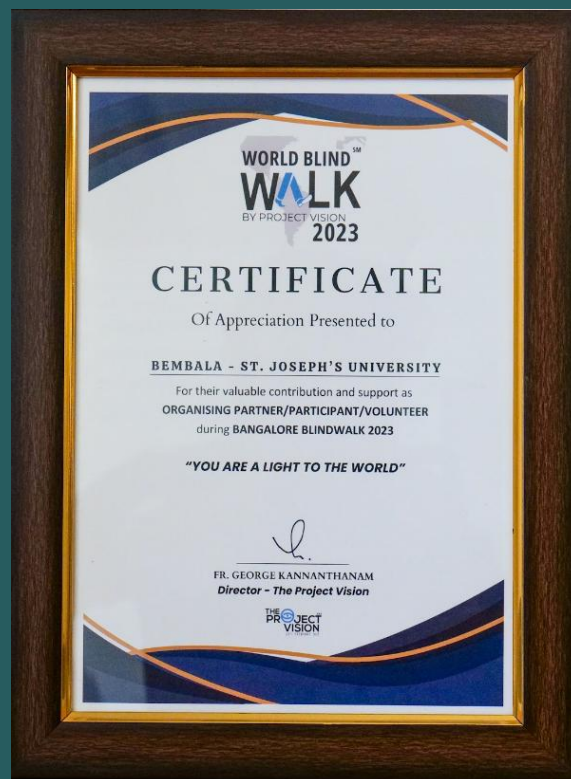
To address the pressing issue of water scarcity in the IT capital, our students launched a save water awareness campaign. They created placards highlighting the importance of water conservation and displayed them at traffic signals and in college, spreading awareness to people of all ages about the need to conserve this precious resource.





BLIND WALK 2023

St. Joseph's Outreach, in collaboration with The Project Vision, organized the 'Blind Walk 2023' on World Sight Day, October 21st, 2023. The event aimed to raise awareness about eye donation and the challenges faced by the visually impaired. Over 700 students participated, walking blindfolded in solidarity with 15 visually impaired individuals. The event concluded with a pledge to promote eye donation and bring hope and clarity to those in need.





RURAL EXPOSURE CAMP

The Bembala-St. Joseph's Outreach Programme organized a Rural Exposure Camp for PG and UG students. The camp aimed to:

- Sensitize students to rural life and social responsibilities
- Develop community development skills
- Foster empathy and understanding of rural challenges

Key Features:

- 800 students participated
- 3-5 day camp in Nelamangal/Solur, Sindagi, and Manvi
- Activities: eco-marches, cleanliness drives, village surveys, cultural programs, and more
- Students designed social work activities based on their experiences

Outcome:

- Students gained valuable insights into rural life
- Developed a sense of social responsibility and empathy
- Returned motivated to make a positive impact in their communities



UG RURAL EXPOSURE CAMP

The 3-day UG Rural Exposure Camp aimed to sensitize undergraduate students to rural realities and social responsibilities. Over 2100 students participated, visiting 35+ villages in Solur and Nelamangala, Ramanagara.

Camp Highlights:

- Exposure to field and brick factory work
- Village visits and interactions
- Special activity discussions and camp evaluation
- Students gained valuable insights into community development and social responsibility

Outcome:

- Students developed empathy and understanding of rural challenges
- Recognized the importance of community involvement and personal transformation



POST-RURAL CAMP ACTIVITIES

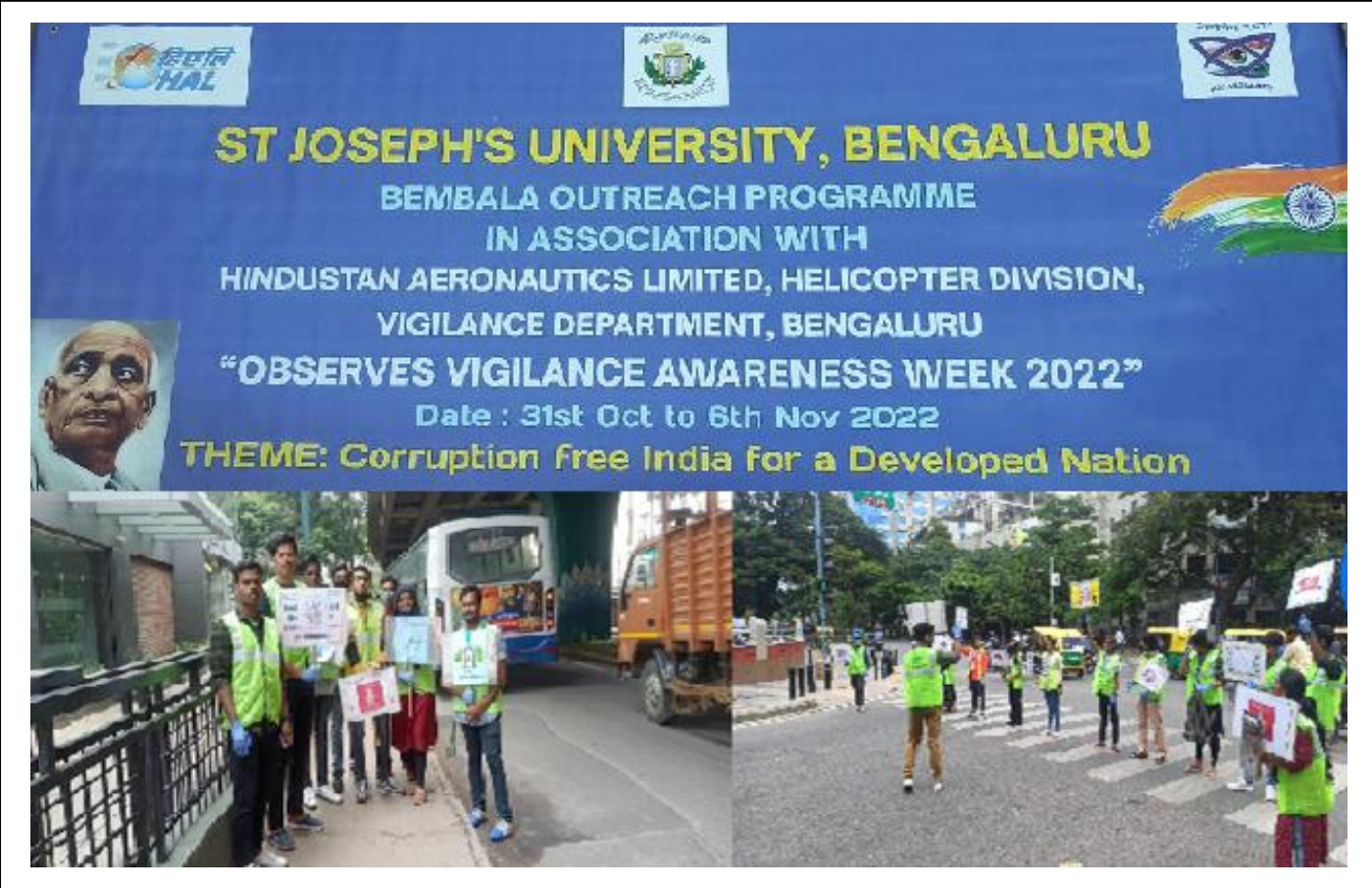
Inspired by their rural camp experiences, students designed innovative projects focused on sustainable development. These initiatives included:

- Painting school walls and setting up visual learning equipment
- Screening short films on social issues
- Plantation drives and community engagement
- Donating groceries and stationery
- Medical and cleanliness drives
- Mental Health Awareness event with booths and resources
- Installing moisture sensors for environmental monitoring
- Interacting with specially abled children at Arpana school, assisting with vocational training, and promoting inclusivity.



VIGILANCE AWARENESS WEEK – AWARENESS ON CORRUPTION

During Vigilance Awareness Week 2022, Hindustan Aeronautics Limited, Helicopter Division, Vigilance Department collaborated with St. Joseph's Institutions to promote the theme "*Corruption Free India for a Developed Nation.*" Students from St. Joseph's University conducted an awareness campaign by creating and displaying posters at traffic signals, engaging with the public on their views about corruption, and performing impactful street plays at various public squares.



PG RURAL EXPOSURE CAMPS AT SINDAGI AND MANVI

A total of 725 final-year PG students (2019 batch) participated in rural exposure camps in Manvi, Panur, and Sindagi. These camps aimed to foster social concern and commitment among students, aligning with the institution's vision of holistic development. The Bembala Team organized innovative activities, including sapling plantation, working in a brick factory, wall painting, village surveys, and street plays addressing social issues. Students also motivated school dropouts to pursue higher education, emphasizing its importance in nation-building.





PAPER COVER MAKING AND DISTRIBUTION

Students made and distributed 12,578 paper bags to local kirana shops and street vendors to raise awareness about reducing plastic usage. This initiative encouraged the public to switch to sustainable alternatives like cloth bags while fostering a sense of environmental responsibility among students.





AWARD FOR ANTI-DRUG CAMPAIGN

Bembala, in collaboration with the Government of Karnataka, organized an Anti-Drug Campaign with the participation of over 1,500 Josephites. The initiative earned Bembala an award from the Excise Department, Government of Karnataka, for its impactful efforts.



WORLD EARTH DAY CLIMATE CHANGE RALLY

On World Earth Day, a rally themed "*Climate Change*" was organized in collaboration with the Ministry of Youth and Sports Affairs, Government of Karnataka. Over 1,000 students participated in the event, showcasing their commitment to environmental sustainability. Bembala was honored with an award from the Ministry for its impactful contribution.





AWARDS AND ACHIEVEMENTS:

The Outreach department in collaboration with the ITC Green Campus initiative, the 'Well-being out of waste' project, fostered a culture of environmental consciousness and sustainable behaviours within the campus and around the campus. The main purpose of the cleanliness drive was to create awareness among the students and people regarding waste segregation and its benefits. Students made posters on the importance of waste segregation and cleanliness. Some students had the opportunity to teach in the Government School in Nanjappa Circle. Students, Data Submission for ITC Award: Our institution has submitted data on our recycling efforts to the ITC Award, demonstrating our commitment to environmental sustainability.

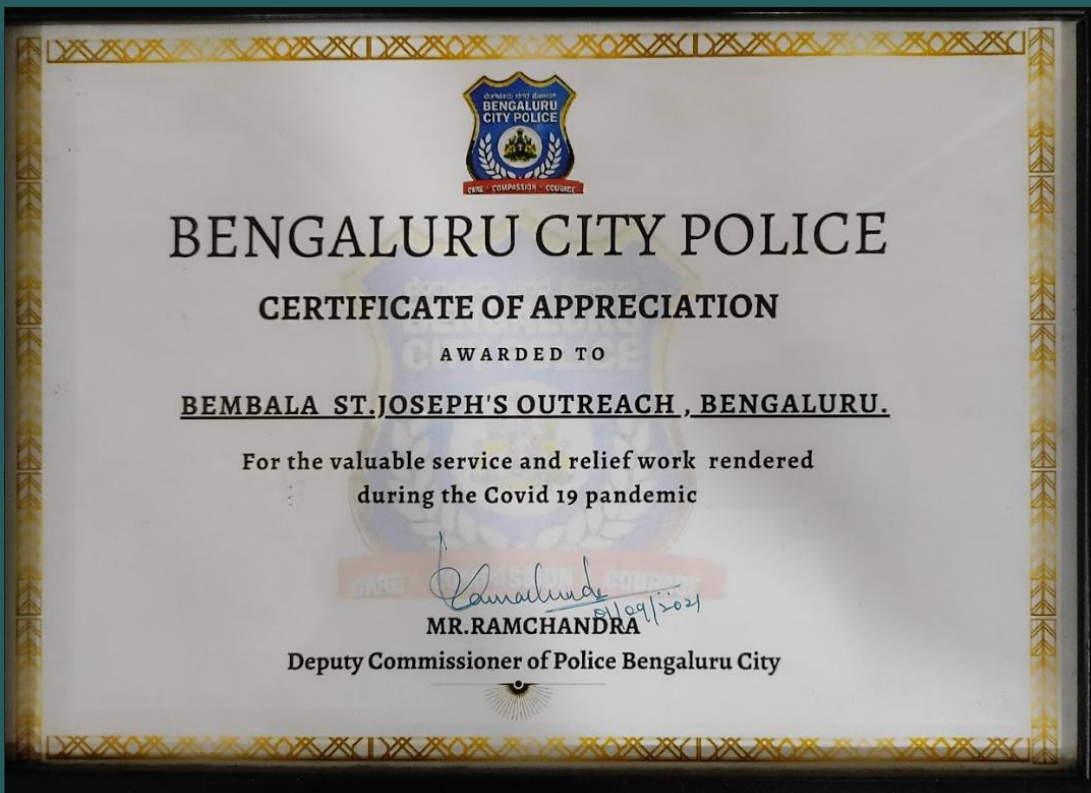


