ELIGIBILITY FOR READMISSION FOR THOSE WHO HAD ATTENDANCE SHORTAGE IN EARLIER SEMESTERS

FOR UNDERGRADUATE (UG) COURSES OF THE EVEN SEMESTER 2024-2025 (For theory and practical courses):

2019 and earlier batch UG students are not eligible to rejoin any semester, even if they have one subject attendance shortage.

2020 batch UG students, except students of the B.Voc program who had an attendance shortage in one course or the entire semester, in theory, need not rejoin the course(s). They can directly apply for the next available regular supplementary examination. They cannot apply for the special supplementary examination. However, 2020 batch B.Voc students are eligible to join the VI semester.

2020 and earlier batch students with attendance shortage in one course or the entire semester in practical are eligible to rejoin the course(s) in II, IV, and VI semesters provided they have got hall tickets to write the theory semester examinations in the respective semesters. They will be allowed to write the practical semester examination only after attending at least 75% of the practical classes held.

The 2021 batch students are eligible to rejoin the IV and VI semesters.

The 2022 batch students are eligible to rejoin the IV semester.

The 2023 batch students are eligible to rejoin 2nd Semester as per the note given below.

Note for students seeking readmission to the II semester: For students readmitted to the II semester (excluding those in B.Voc., B.A. Visual Communication, B.Com, BBA, and BCA), the syllabus for the additional subject from the I semester must be studied independently or with support from the respective department faculty. These students will take the end-semester examination for the additional subject as a supplementary exam during their III semester. Please note that students must apply for the supplementary examination when it is announced by the Controller of Examinations.

Additionally, these students must complete two activities for the Continuous Assessment (CA) marks of the I semester. They should approach the respective Heads of Departments (HoDs) for guidance in completing these activities and in studying the additional subject while continuing their III semester. Students must also apply for the makeup test for the additional subject, which will be notified by the Controller of Examinations, and sit for the mid-semester test during their III semester.

FOR POSTGRADUATE COURSES OF THE EVEN SEMESTER 2024-2025 (For theory and practical courses):

2020 and earlier batch PG students are not eligible to rejoin any semester, even if they have one subject attendance shortage.

2021 batch PG students are eligible to rejoin the IV semester either for the entire semester or for a course in that semester. 2021 batch PG students are eligible to rejoin for a course in the II semester but not for the semester.

2022 batch PG students are eligible to rejoin II and IV semesters either for the entire semester or for a course in that semester.

2023 batch students are eligible to rejoin the II semester.

Students seeking readmission who received a hall ticket for the practical examination but not for the theory examination must register only for the theory exam, and vice versa.

IMPORTANT NOTE: As per the resolution passed in the Academic Council 4.8 dated 2nd April 2024, it is resolved to allow students with attendance shortages in one subject to be readmitted only after the VI semester of their Bachelor's program or IV semester of their Master's program. However, if a student is free from the regular semester schedule, they may be readmitted in that semester to fulfill the requirement for the subject with an attendance shortage.
