REGISTRATION EXPRESSING WILLINGNESS TO ATTEND THE SUMMER COURSE

This notice is for UG students who have back papers in both odd and even semesters. You are directed to register your willingness to enroll in a summer course to clear your back papers.

Registration Process:

- 1. Use the Google form link provided below to indicate your willingness to enroll in a course.
- 2. You can register your willingness for more than one course, but can enroll for only one core course (including Language and General English) and one non-core course (IGNITORS, HRD, Theology, Foundation course, Skill development course).

Important Notes:

Registering your willingness does not guarantee that the course will be offered in summer.

The administration will decide on the courses to be offered based on the number of students and notify you in the first week of February.

Students who were denied hall tickets for a single course and students who wish to improve their CA marks can also complete the course in this summer programme.

Benefits:

6th semester students having one back paper in 1,2,3 or 4th can clear the course in summer and this will help them save one academic year.

Those who were denied hall ticket for a single subject can save one academic year by enrolling for the course in summer, if it is offered.

Students can improve their CA marks.

Course Details:

Classes will be conducted for a single course.

Examinations will be conducted immediately after the classes. (Total 12 days)

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DETAILS OF SUMMER PROGRAMME

The classes will start on the following day after the last day of the even semester examination as per the Semester examination schedule. Two sessions of classes of $1\frac{1}{2}$ hrs duration will be held from 9 am to 12.30 pm with a break of half an hour. The students will be given assignments (for 3 hrs duration) within the syllabus. The students are expected to be there in the Library from 2pm-5pm and complete the assignments. Eligibility: All students who had failed in the previous semester examinations are eligible to register for Summer courses.

Students who were denied hall tickets for one course are eligible to register for Summer courses. Students can register for only one core course and one non core course during a given summer class. No practical course will be offered during Summer registration.

Both odd and even semester courses may be offered by the department. The classes for non core courses will be conducted for one or two days only.
