SEMESTER EXAMINATION: OCTOBER 2024

(Practical, Viva- Voce and Theory Subjects)

(To be conducted in November 2024)

It is hereby notified that the 1st, 3rd and 5th semester UG and 1st and 3rd semester PG regular and supplementary practical, Viva-Voce examinations will commence on the 14th of October 2024 and theory examination from the 7th of November 2024 .

A detailed timetable for theory examination is put up on the University website and the examination notice board.

Hall tickets for the Regular Students:

Hall tickets for the theory examination will be released at 1 pm on the 4th of November 2024 for the eligible candidates.

FOR SUPPLEMENTARY CANDIDATES ONLY

UG students whose registration number starts with 19 and above can register for supplementary examinations for odd semester Practical, Viva Voce and theory courses from 10 am on the 24th of September 2024 through the Linways portal. The last date to apply for the supplementary examination is **3 pm on the 7th of October 2024 without a fine and 3 pm on the 9th of October 2024 with a fine of Rs 200/per paper.**

Issues related to registration in the Linways portal and payment of fees, if any, shall be addressed to the IT cell. (itcellexam@sju.edu.in)

Eligibility: Students whose registration number starts with 20 and above are eligible to apply for the undergraduate supplementary examination. Students whose registration number starts with 21 and above can apply for the Postgraduate supplementary examination.

Special Cases:

a)Additional academic year candidates: UG students whose registration number starts with 19 and PG students whose registration number starts with 20 and who had requested for the additional academic year to complete the programme and got the approval for the same must register for the supplementary

examination **offline** in the office of the COE and pay the examination fees. The last date for applying for supplementary examination remains the same as given for other supplementary candidates. A recent passport size photograph must be affixed on the hall ticket form.

b) Candidate registered for a single subject in odd semester : Candidates who had enrolled for a single subject in the odd semester must apply for the supplementary examinations for the same course. Such candidates must register for the supplementary examination **offline** in the office of the COE. They need not have to pay the supplementary examination fee.

The last date for applying for supplementary examination under this category remains the same as given for other supplementary candidates.

Kindly submit the copies of all marks cards for those semester(s) in which supplementary examinations are to be written. A recent passport size photograph must be affixed on the hall ticket form. Candidates must write the examination in the current syllabus.

c) NEP students with attendance shortage for one subject in the 1st and 3rd semester: UG Candidates whose registration number starts with 21 & 23 who had attendance shortage in one subject in the 1st semester can apply for the supplementary examination online. They need not have to attend classes. UG Candidates whose registration number starts with 22 who had attendance shortage in one subject in 1st and 3rd can apply for the supplementary examination online. They need not have to attend classes.

d) One-time last chance candidates: Students whose registration number starts with 17 and less (Bangalore University batches) must register for the odd semester supplementary examination **offline** in the office of the COE. The last date for applying for supplementary examination under this category remains the same as given for other supplementary candidates.

Kindly submit the copies of all marks cards for those semester(s) in which supplementary examinations are to be written. A recent passport size photograph must be affixed on the hall ticket form. Candidates must write the examination in the current syllabus.

e) Term paper: Students who had to submit the Term paper may register for the supplementary examination online as mentioned above. The last date for applying for supplementary Term paper examination remains the same as given for other supplementary candidates. **The soft copy of the Term Paper must be sent to the guides latest by 3 pm on the 4th of November 2024.** Term paper will not be evaluated, if the student fails to submit it before the deadline.

Practical, Viva- Voce, Dissertation and Project Supplementary Examination:

Students can apply for the Practical, Viva- Voce, Dissertation and Project supplementary examination in the same way as given for the theory examination. The last date for applying for supplementary practical examination remains the same as given for theory supplementary examination. **All those who**

had applied for the practical, Viva- Voce, Dissertation and Project supplementary examination will be issued a separate hard copy of the hall ticket in the Examination section on the 10th of October 2024. After receiving the hall ticket form, they must get the slots for examination from the respective Head of the departments. Please note that the dates and time must be written on the hallticket by the HODs. This information must be registered in the examination helpdesk on the same day.

Hall tickets for the supplementary theory examinations:

Hall tickets will be released on the 4th of November 2024 for those who have registered and paid the fee for the supplementary examination. Those who had applied offline must collect the hall ticket from the Examination section on or after the 4th of November 2024 from 10am-3pm.

Syllabus for the supplementary examination:

As per the rules of the University, if a syllabus has been changed for a course, (indicated by the last two digits in the code number) the candidate will get two additional chances to write the examination in the old syllabus. (This is calculated from the year in which the syllabus was changed). If the course was discontinued from the given semester, the candidate will get three additional chances to write the examination in the old syllabus. For some special cases, one more chance in the old syllabus will be given and the details will be posted on the University website on 7th of October 2024. I and 3 semester UG supplementary non NEP batch students will continue getting the Question paper in the same syllabus and pattern as per 2020 odd semester examination.
