- Ration card, voter ID, or other identity proofs
- UHID (Unique Household ID) number sticker on your electricity meter or house
- Educational certificates (diplomas/degrees)
- Income proof, caste certificates, land/property documents
- Bank account details if applicable

- There are two ways to participate: self-declaration via the online portal or enumerator home visits by government officials using a mobile app for data entry.

- The survey is mandatory and important for government planning and welfare schemes.
