Reference Letters

- ▶ Applicants will nominate 2 referees in the application form, providing name, designation and email ID
- Referees receive a system generated email directly from Reliance Foundation Scholarships with information on how to submit the reference.
 The letter of recommendation must be on the referee's organisation's letterhead, signed, and uploaded in pdf format.
- ▶ Referees will have until 24th December 2023 to submit their references 1 week longer than the application deadline.

What do the Reference Letters consist of?

- One academic reference: This letter should be from an academic who can comment in detail on your academic ability and how well they think you would do at the university you are applying to.
- One character reference: This letter should be from a person who can speak in detail about your character and comment critically on whether your extra-curricular, non-academic requirements and leadership traits are aligned with the scholarship's criteria.
