Admissions, New Programmes, Student Orientation

The 2023-24 academic year began with the first student orientation programme held at St Joseph's University was conducted on the 14, 15 and 17 July 2023.

A total of 3274 students were admitted for various UG courses and 811 in PG courses at the University. This year, the University has over 9852 students and 552 staff. Around 50 faculty members and 20 non-teaching staff joined our Josephite family and we warmly welcome them. On the same date, Shift III held their students' orientation in the auditorium at 5 pm.

The University proudly offers 47 UG programmes, 22 PG programmes, 5 PhD programmes and 4 Diploma programmes. This year 35 different certificate courses were offered, which included diversified areas such as cinema, music, dance, martial arts, culinary science, computer science, psychology and many more, to manifest the student's interest into a career opportunity. More than 2800 SJU students and external participants have enrolled for these courses this year.

Infrastructure Update

In the academic Year 2023-24, the 4th floor of the Science Block was expanded to house new laboratories, staff rooms, research laboratories, cabinets for PhD students and counselling rooms. Major renovations of the Examination Section and IQAC office were also successfully completed on 18 August 2023 and were inaugurated on the same day. This includes buying new computer systems and setting up new labs, undertaking renovations of various department staff rooms and upgradation of many staff and common toilets.

Library

SJU Library is the brains of the campus and caters to the needs of more than 9000 undergraduate, postgraduate and research-level staff and students. With a mission to provide quality resources and innovative services to stimulate creativity, and intellectual curiosity and facilitate learning and research, the Central Library boasts 56297 books, 7035 Reference books, 837 back bounded volumes, 1168 book bank books, 936 donated books, 671 student dissertations, 38 magazines, 15 newspapers, 40 journals. And the library has seen nearly 23900 visitors this year.

Scholarships

So far, for the year 2023-24, An amount of Rs 38,38,103/- was received from the Private, government and other benefactors this year. The management has lent support in the form of management scholarships to the tune of Rs. 2,03,45,760/- for 2023-24 bringing it to a total of Rs 2,41,83,863/-. Around 1300 students have benefitted from this.

Examination Section

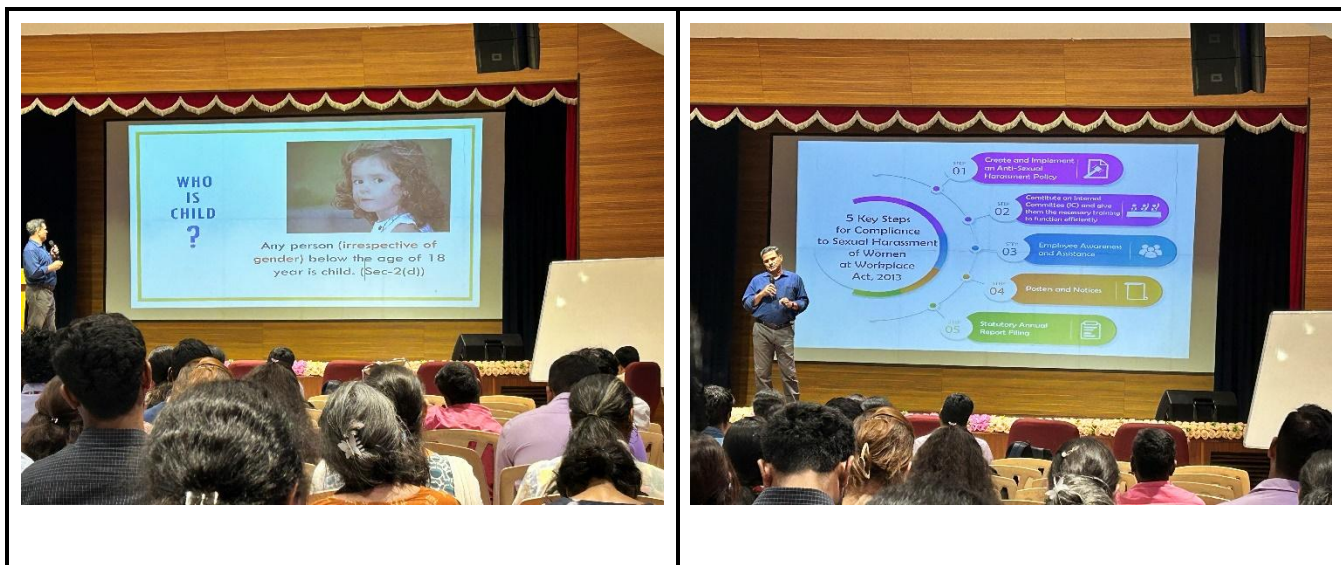
All students who were in need of results and certificates for further studies were provided the same out-of-turn. This year, for the April 2023 examinations, 7192 UG students appeared of whom 5103 cleared, while 1428 PG students appeared of whom 1325 passed the examination bringing the pass percentage to 70.95% and 92.79% respectively. The odd semester examinations held in October 2023 saw 7827 UG and 1577 PG students appear, of whom 5816 UG and 1447 PG students cleared the examinations. The University conducted centralised Board of Studies meetings for all departments. This exercise helps departments to focus on relevance and quality in their syllabi. The entire work relating to the Examination division has been fully computerised and we are now gearing up for the upcoming even semester examinations.

Towards the future, the examination section hopes to implement summer registrations for courses with more failures, and Biometric attendance for PG examination candidates.

St Joseph's Research Institute (SJRI)

The primary objective of SJRI is to enable and facilitate research at SJU as well as to set benchmarks and standards for the same. The hallmark of a University is the generation of knowledge through research in diverse domains carried out by its faculty and students. 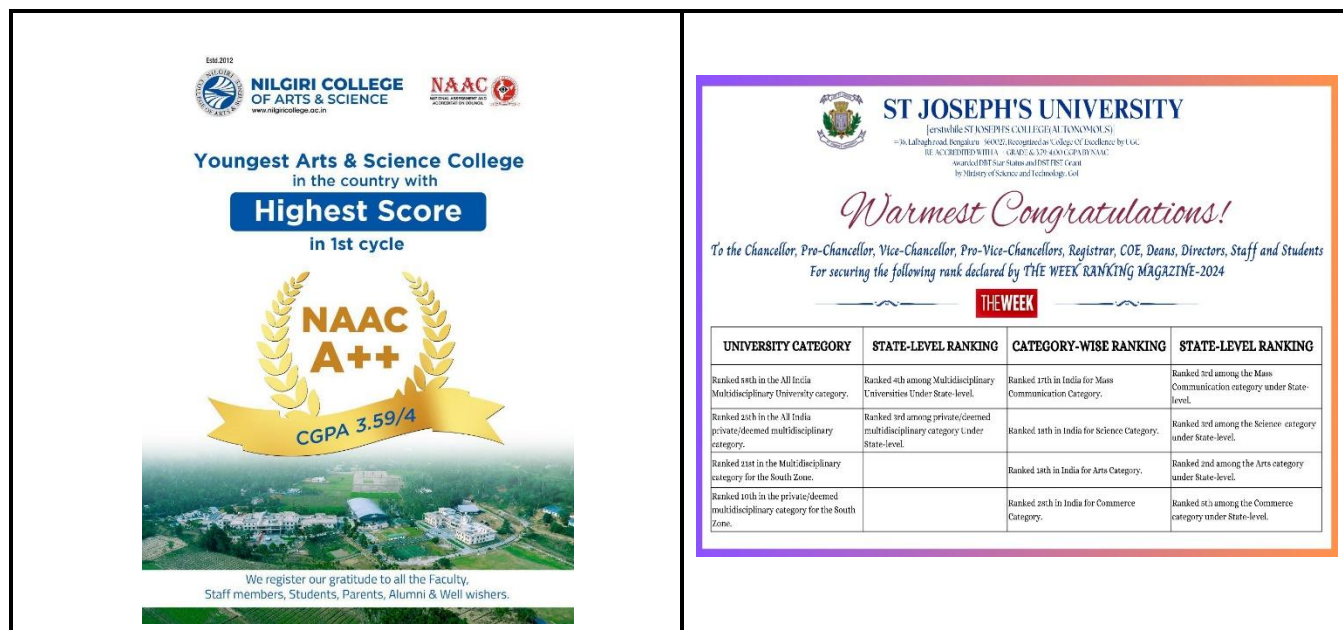

IQAC

SJU (formerly SJC) has been placed at the Band Rank of 100-150 in the 2023 NIRF Ranking. Likewise, the college has been placed highly in the *India Today* and *The Week* rankings for the year 2023.

The Student Council elections were held abiding by the stringent process and scrutiny on 14 August 2023. The newly elected council was inducted in a formal investiture ceremony on 31 August at 3:00 pm at the University auditorium with Mr Hamza Hussain, illustrious Alumnus and Dr Swetha Raghavan, Head of Innovation, Engagement, & Govt. affairs for India and South Asia, presiding as the Chief Guest and Guest of Honour, respectively.

SJU buzzed with the vibrant essence of *Thiruvonam* as students convened in the Arrupe Atrium to celebrate the traditional festival on 29 August 2023.

In a historic first, the Student Council organised Swagath '23, an event to welcome the freshers into the University, various engaging ice-breaker events were organised for them throughout the Swagath week.

Prathibha 2023, themed "JASHAN-E-ARAB," was a vibrant celebration organised by the Student Council on 9 October 2023. Spanning across the university's eight schools, the annual intra-university fest showcased a spirited atmosphere of competition. It featured 42 cultural events hosted by various associations of the university.

The flagship intercollegiate fest of SJU, Visages, emerged as the most anticipated event of the year, blending cultural, academic, and sports events into a vibrant celebration of talent and creativity on 9 and 10 February 2024.

Tejas 2024, the interclass Cultural Fest for Shift-III, commenced on 16 March 2024 with an impressive launch event. The launch featured the unveiling of banners and trophies, accompanied by a vibrant food fest organised by the students. Throughout the week, a total of 30 diverse competitions were held, captivating the attention and participation of students from 19 different classes. These competitions ranged from performing arts to literary endeavours, offering a platform for students to showcase their skills and talents. The fest culminated on 23 March with a grand finale and valedictory ceremony.

Parents' Council

Republic Day Celebrations



Three of our cadets of 1 KAR AIR SQN NCC, CWO Prajwal Tenginkai (II BBA, Shift-III), CWO Manya Kenchain DJ (II BSc CHBT) and CDT/SGT Joel J Mammen (II BCom), were part of the PM Rally in the Republic Day Camp 2024. CWO Prajwal Tenginkai was conferred with the All-India Best Cadet gold medal by the Hon'ble Prime Minister on Republic Day 2024 while CWO Manya Kenchain DJ won the All-India silver medal in the Best Cadet Competition. This marks the second consecutive year that one of our cadets won gold.

Public Relations Office (PRO)

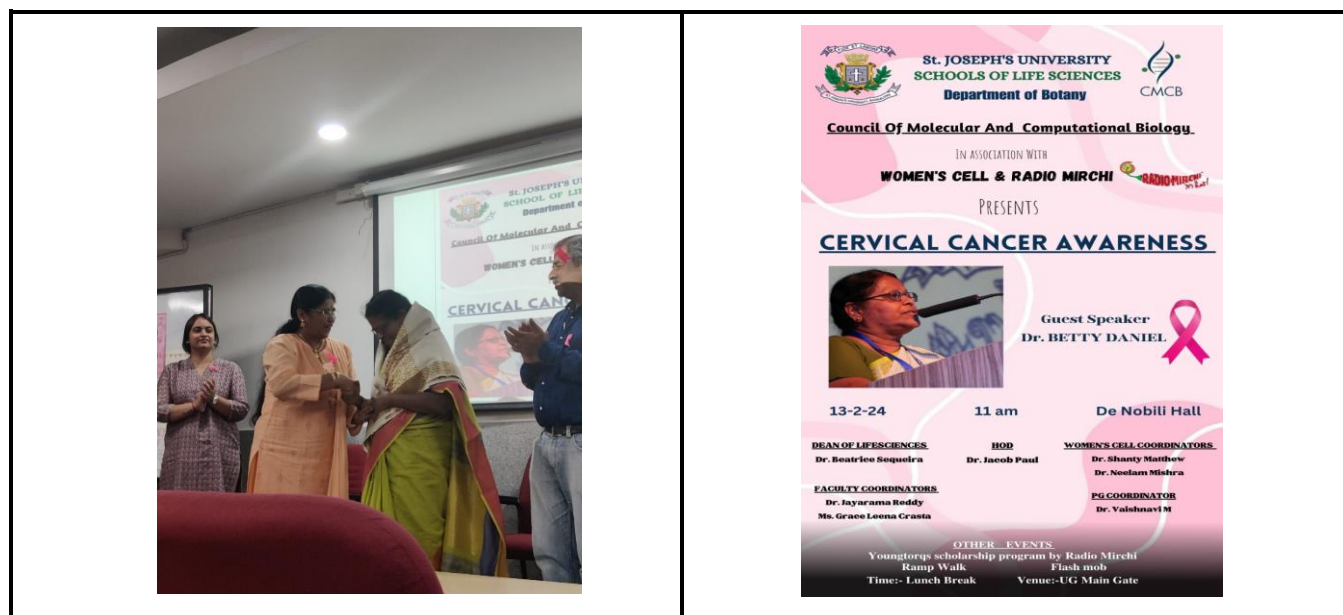

Mentorship



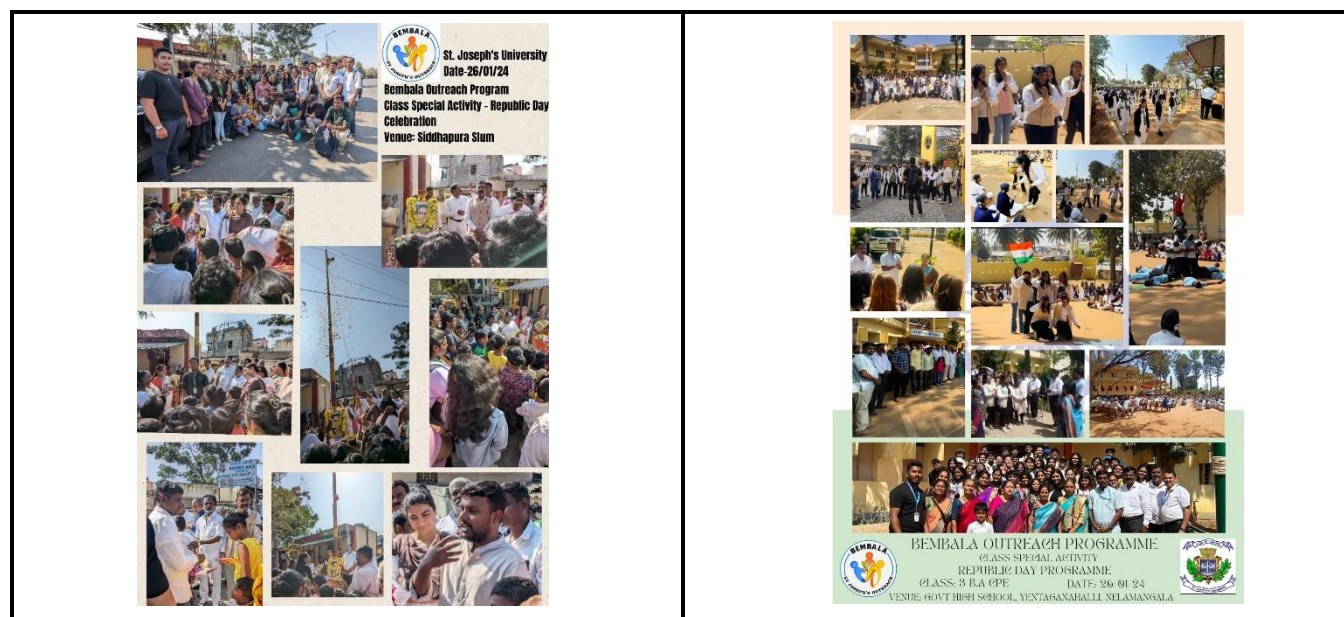
The Chancellor has directed the university's administration to train the faculty on basic counselling skills and effective mentoring so that mentors acquire the required skills to guide the mentees. It is the Jesuit perspective that every student passing through the doorways of our institution should obtain good mentorship and care. The University has developed a mentoring record to execute this approach more effectively and efficiently. This aids in documenting all mentoring activities. Additionally, this year, SJU sent a team of mentors and welfare officers for a holistic training course conducted by Samagra the St Joseph's Holistic Wellness Centre from August 2023 to April 2024. This training, held in batches, aims to help teachers reflect on their interaction with the students and prepare them for accompanying their students from an informed and compassionate place.

From 31 January till May 2024, all Saturdays were used for Teaching, Learning and Evaluation workshops to train the teachers school-wise. Dr Ronald (Pro-Vice-Chancellor) conducted the teaching, learning and evaluation workshop between 9:00 am to 4:30 pm. The resource person was Dr Michael Rajamathi. All the faculty members were the participants in this workshop.

KAIROS

A session was conducted by the Samagra team headed by Fr Brian at SJU where final-year mentors along with their mentees were involved in prayers and activities. It was a gratitude session where students thanked their classmates, teachers and mentors. In a way, the students thanked the institution and the resources, which helped them in their study years.

Outreach



Bembala is the Outreach segment of SJU. Students are taught the importance of community service and how we can help those who are less privileged. Some of the major projects taken by Bembala during the year 2023-24 includes: Traffic awareness drive, Paper bag making and distribution to local shops, a Cleanliness drive in collaboration with ITC Green Campus, Visit to 'APARNA'-the school for children with special abilities, Blind Walk 2023 in collaboration with The Project Vision to commemorate the

'World Sight Day' on 21 October 2023, Rural Exposure Camps for the final year UG and PG students, Save Water Awareness Drive and many more. The events and programmes aim to promote social responsibility and community-centric development among students, encouraging them to contribute to society while achieving their academic excellence and character development.

NSS

SJU has 5 NSS units, each one aiming for students' character building by involving them in various activities of service throughout the year. They conducted activities such as blood donation camps, trekking camps, Swachhata Abhiyan clean-up drives, job fairs, competitions and quizzes to name a few. NSS Exposure Camps were organised by all five units. These camps help volunteers understand the socio-economic and cultural conditions of rural life. The camp also helps inculcate the true sense of oneness and the cultural condition of rural knowledge.

This year's highlight activities were 'Together for Dementia - The Blue Button Movement' organised in collaboration with Nightingale Medical Trust (NMT) and Dementia India Alliance. A walkathon was organised in collaboration with Namma Bengaluru Foundation, Youth Red Cross, Lions Club and Sparsh Hospital, with the theme 'Heartbeat Hustle: Walk for a Healthy Heart' as an effort to create a movement towards a healthier heart.

Students represented the University at the Karnataka State Republic Day. 20 Volunteers Represented National Integration camps and 10 students participated in the Karnataka state Youth festival camp.

Skill Acquisition

A guest lecture on "Make your Mark: A Journey from Campus to Corporate" was organised for the students of Shift-III, SJU on 26 February 2024 from 7.00 pm to 9.00 pm in the main auditorium of the university. The resource person, Ms Shwetha N, a Training Manager for Business Process and CRM Delivery at IDP Education India Pvt Ltd addressed the students on the importance of personal branding to succeed in one's career. She emphasised the importance of acquiring skills during their stay at the university and simultaneously building their brand through networking on social media platforms such as LinkedIn, Instagram, etc. She also gave some tips to the students and various methods of branding oneself.

Campus Ministry

The Campus Ministry at SJU is a vibrant team of teaching faculty who take care of the corporal and spiritual needs of students and staff members. Holy mass is organised every Friday. Four special masses are celebrated for the inauguration of the academic year, the feasts of St Joseph, St Ignatius of Loyola, and Christmas. The Campus Ministry organises HRD classes for non-Catholic students and theology classes for second-semester Catholic students.

The Campus Ministry team started the academic year with prayer and blessing sessions for the new staff, students and all the existing students and staff. In line with the requirement, the KJES Youth Works in collaboration with the BJES - Bembala Team and Campus Ministry of SJU organised Ignitors Integral Formation Programme.

A total of 2300 catholic students of our university on 14 and 28 Oct 2023 attended the ANNUAL RETREAT conducted by the campus ministry team. The retreat aimed to provide a space for spiritual growth, deepening of faith, and fostering a sense of community among the youth.

Feast of St Ignatius of Loyola Eucharistic Celebration on 1 August 2023. The main celebrant was Rev Msgr S Jayanathan and con-celebrants were all Jesuit priests in the campus.

SJU Sports Day



The University conducted the 140th Annual Athletic Meet (**SJU Sports Day**) on 19 January 2024 on the University grounds and the chief guest was Ms Sucheta Deb Barman, an international open-water swimmer. There were many events conducted including a 4x100 m Relay for the staff both teaching and non-teaching. SJU also organised **SPORTSTAKES** - 2024, an Inter College Sports Fest from 12 to 16 March 2024 for 11 different games (Badminton, Basketball, Carrom, Chess, Football, Handball, Kabaddi, Kho-Kho, Table Tennis, Throwball and Volleyball)

Josephite Choir

The Josephite Choir is one of the oldest associations of the institution. It takes immense pride in being the only student-led Choir in all of Bangalore. 'Festival of Harmony' a national-level Gospel Fest organised by the Glorious Choir marked the beginning of the journey of the Choir for the academic year 2023-24.

The choir participated in several competitions around the year and won many prizes. In the Annual Sing Song Competition Hosted by the East Parade CSI Tamil Church; Ms Anna Jose won first place in the western solo singing; Conductor, Mr Shalom Sabu won the first place in the vernacular solo singing competition. The choir bagged the first prize in the Institution category of the competition. The choir also had the privilege to sing in front of esteemed personalities like the former President of India Shri. Ram Nath Kovind, Director General of CSIR. Dr N Kalaiselvi and Shri Dinesh Gundu Rao. At the RD Camp, New Delhi, in January 2024, CWO Prajwal won the All-India Best Cadet award, and CWO Manya won the silver All-India Best Cadet Award Competition. Cadet Joel was selected for the PM Rally.
