

SCIENTIFIC EXCHANGES IN SWIZERLAND

Researchers from abroad to Switzerland are funded for a period of 1 to 6 months.

Research visits are visits by the applicant at an institution abroad or visits by a guest from abroad at the applicant's institution. The research visits:

- a. must be devoted to scientific cooperation and exchanges in the subject area of the research questions addressed by the applicant and must be deemed likely to add value to their research;
- b. must include a concrete plan for joint scientific/research activities of the applicant and the guest or a responsible person at the host institution;
- c. must last between one month and six months;
- d. may take place anywhere in the world.

The guest or the responsible partner-person at the host institution must be scientifically qualified to carry out the planned joint activities. At the host institution or the applicant's institution, access to the infrastructure must be guaranteed and other requirements for a promising collaboration must be met.

What is covered:

Scientific events, travel expenses, accommodation and meals of participants from abroad as well as certain costs of online or hybrid events are covered, for research visits those of travelling guests.
