Guidelines for Ignitors Assessment

Study material (42 pages) is forwarded in class WhatsApp group. Students are asked to go through the materials and take active participation in the assessment.

Ignitors assessment module has 3 aspects:

- i. Attendance 80%
- ii. Assignment – Mind map
- iii. Video Creation

Action Plan for Mind map and Video creation:

1. Entire class students are divided into 8 groups
2. Each group is assigned with one topic and a leader in-charge
3. Students are asked to prepare a **Creative Mind map** in a **Chart** to project what, why and how of the assigned topic depicting what they have learnt, inspired, what they want to change in their life, etc. by going through the study materials, recalling class activities, etc.
4. Students are asked to create a **Short Video** (3-5 minutes) in which each student should explain their understanding of the topic, what they have presented in the mind map, etc.
5. Group in-charge is asked to motivate the students, find time and complete the mind map and video and submit to Class Representative
6. Class representatives are asked to collect all 8 mind maps and scan to make it as single PDF with the label of their class name (e.g. BCA – DA – Ignitors – Mind map) and submit to concern faculty both hard and soft copy on or before the deadline
7. Class representatives are also asked to collect the videos and submit to the concern faculty on or before the deadline
8. Feel free to approach Life Skills Trainers who handled Ignitors Sessions, seated in **S406** for further clarification, support and submission of assignments
