Mid-Semester Examination Rules and Guidelines

Identity Cards and Dress Code

- Except I-semester students, all other candidates must possess their University-issued Identity Cards during the examination.
- Students must wear proper dress as per the guidelines in the college handbook.

Examination Room Rules

- Candidates will only be permitted to enter the examination room 10 minutes before the exam.
- Students should not be in the classrooms or corridors before this time.
- Leave all bags near the door inside the room before taking your seat.
- Bring your own stationery, calculators, dictionaries, etc. Borrowing is not permitted without the invigilator's permission.

Conduct During the Examination

- Do not write anything related to the exam on desks or benches.
- Report any pre-written material to the invigilator.
- No communication between students is allowed.
- Address questions only to the invigilator.

Prohibited Items

- Mobile phones
- Smartwatches
- Digital diaries/electronic organizers
- Books or papers
- Any material that could facilitate cheating

Malpractice

- Possession of prohibited items will be considered malpractice.
- Writing on the body or desks/benches is also considered malpractice.
- Arguing or misbehaving with invigilators/examination officials is malpractice.
- Follow instructions if malpractice is reported.

Additional Rules

- No writing pads or pencil pouches are allowed in the examination hall.
- Use only black ink or dark blue ink pens for writing.
- Students arriving after 10 minutes will not be allowed to write the paper.
- No student can leave the examination hall before 35 minutes after commencement.

Malpractice Prevention Rules

- Students are directed to review these rules.
